

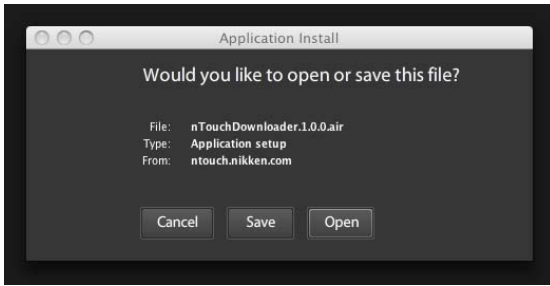
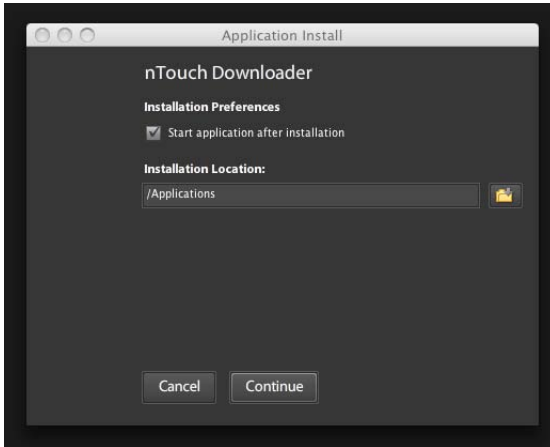


Instructions for Downloading and Presenting your Rhythm Slideshow

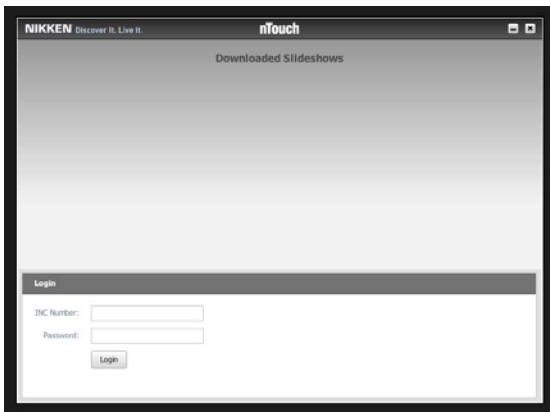
	<p>Access your nTouch account from any computer with an internet connection</p>
	<p>Once the Rhythm SlideShow has been added to your library you can customize it as you would any nTouch SlideShow.</p>
	<p>You must completely finish all personalization and customization to the presentation before downloading it.</p>
	<p>Using the computer on which you will be presenting download the nTouch Downloader. This will require an internet connection.</p>
	<p>You can get the nTouch Downloader from: http://ntouch.nikken.com/downloader/</p>
	<p>Click “Install Now”</p>
	<p>Click “Install”</p>



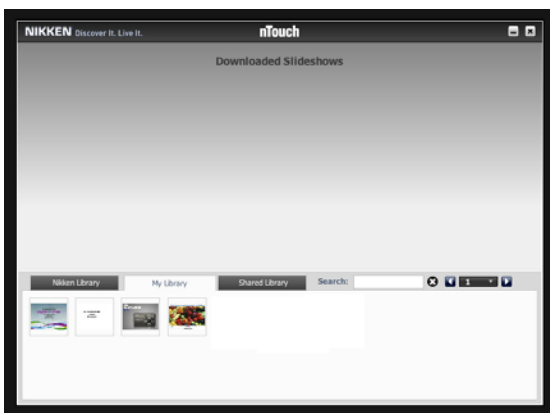
Click “Open”



By default, the nTouch Downloader will be located with the rest of your programs/applications on your computer. If you are on a PC this would be in your Program Files folder. On a Mac, it will be in the Applications folder. It is recommended to use this default installation location.

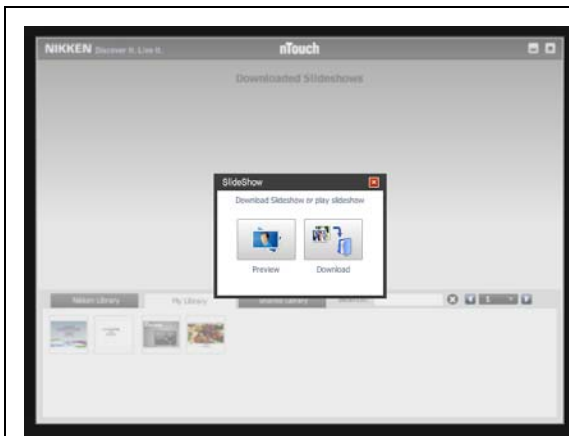


The nTouch Downloader should launch automatically after installation, but can be launched just like any other program on your computer. Once loaded, enter your INC number and nTouch password.

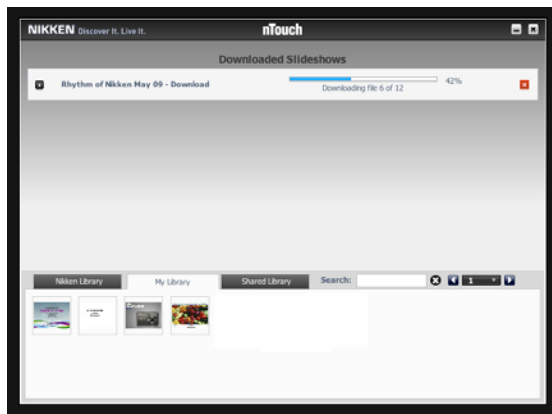


If you have copied a version of the Rhythm SlideShow, you should see it under the My Library tab. If you have chosen not to customize the presentation you can just download the original version from the Nikken Library.

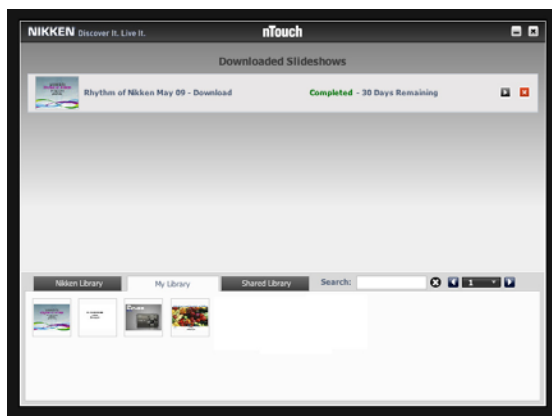
Double-click the thumbnail to open the download options.



Click “Download”



The presentation is now downloading all the necessary components to your computer. The amount of time this requires depends on your internet connections speed. Allow at least 30-45 minutes for completion.



Once the download is complete you can remove your internet connection and run this presentation from your computer. Double-clicking the thumbnail icon will launch the presentation full screen.



Once the presentation has launched you can advance/backup the presentation by using the left/right arrow keys on your keyboard. Hitting ESC will exit from the presentation. Alternately, you can move the mouse up to the top of the presentation to reveal the controls.
